In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 11 of the Airport Security Force Act, 1975, the Federal Government is pleased to prescribe hereunder, the method, qualifications and other conditions for appointment to the following posts in the Airport Security Force under Ministry of Defence:—

2. **Method of Appointment.**—The above posts shall be filled as follows:—

Provided that if no suitable person is available for promotion, the post or posts reserved for promotion shall be filled by initial appointment and failing that by transfer.

3. **Condition for Promotion.**—Promotion to posts in column 1 below shall be made by selection from amongst the persons who hold the posts specified



in column 2 on a regular basis and possess the qualifications and experience prescribed in column 3:—

4. **Qualifications Experience Age Limits for Initial Appointment.**—A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits mentioned against the post in the Schedule to this notification, provided that:—

- (i) 'Experience' means, the experience gained in regular full time paid job after attaining the prescribed basic qualifications. Period spent on studies whether inside or outside the country, during service except for M.Phil or Ph.D. in relevant field will be excluded from the total length of experience.



(ii) The maximum age limits will be relaxed up to the age of 55 years, wherever applicable, for appointment to all posts in the Federal Government as follows:—

- (a) by three years in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Buddhist Community, recognized tribes of the Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir and the Northern Areas;
- (b) by not more than ten years in the case of Government Servants who have completed at least 2 years continuous government service on the closing date for submission of application;
- (c) by ten years or the number of years served in the Armed Forces, whichever is less, in the case of released or retired Officers/Personnel of the Armed Forces of Pakistan;

Only one of the relaxations mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above shall be allowed.

(iii) Eligibility of candidates shall be reckoned as on the closing date fixed for the submission of applications, in accordance with the Recruitment Rules and the Instructions issued by the Government and the F.P.S.C.

**5. Appointment by Transfer.**—Appointment by transfer shall be made by selection from amongst the persons holding appointment on a regular basis under the Federal Government in the same basic pay scale in which the post to be filled exists, provided that the person concerned possesses the qualifications and experience prescribed for initial appointment or promotion to the post concerned.

**6. Probation.**—Persons appointed by promotion or initial appointment or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded, or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973.

**7.** This notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Division *vide* their O.M. No. 1/1/89-R-5, dated 7th May, 1995 & 20th March, 1996 and F.P.S.C., *vide* its letter No. F-12-11/95-S, dated 22nd October, 1995 respectively. This supersedes Ministry of Defence (Aviation Wing) Notification No. 236/76, dated 23rd January, 1976.

## NOTIFICATION

Islamabad, the 21st April, 1996

S. R. O. 44 (KE) 96 :

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) of section 3 and section 4 of the Sports (Development and Control) Ordinance, 1962 (XVI of 1962), the Federal Government is pleased to constitute a Board for the promotion and development of women sports in Pakistan, to be called, the WOMEN SPORTS BOARD.

The Constitution of the Board shall be as under :—

(a) The Special Assistant to the Prime Minister on Social Sector — President.



- (b) The Secretary/Additional Secretary Incharge, Sports and Tourism - Senior Vice President.
- (c) Chairperson, Organizing Committee - Vice President.
- (d) The Organizing Secretary - Secretary.
- (e) Such other members as may be notified by the Federal Government from time to time.

The powers, functions and other provisions of the said Board shall be such as are provided in the rules.
